- We welcome students from all over the world from various educational and professional backgrounds and thus retain a student body that is both diverse and unique.
- > Students are able to benefit from the rich inspiration of Paris with all its cultural and filmic traditions while retaining the core of an international education.

COLLABORATIONS















The Bachelor and the Master of Fine Arts programs are designed to give students professional preparation for a career in film, television or digital media. This is accomplished through theoretical courses and practical exercises as well as extensive hands-on film work where students have the opportunity to master the technical and aesthetic principles of filmmaking.

BACHELOR OF FINE ARTS

- The first year consists of mastering the fundamentals in the key disciplines of filmmaking in a predominately hands-on film curriculum coupled with theoretical and film culture classes in the first and second terms. The third term, students will only work, in various capacities, on student productions.
- In the second year, students will choose an option – directing, production, cinematography, screenwriting or editing. During the second term, students have additional required courses in their option as well as workshops, and one-to-one tutoring.
- In the third and final year, the emphasis is on the student's final film project in the area of their option. All third year courses and workshops are tailored to the specificities of the students' final project film.

ONE YEAR FILMMAKING PROGRAM

The One Year Filmmaking Program is a one year comprehensive program in filmmaking introducing students to the fundamentals – directing, screenwriting, cinematography, production or editing – of the art and craft of film production in a predominately hands-on film curriculum with relevant theoretical and film culture classes.

MASTER OF FINE ARTS

The MFA 2 year Program at EICAR is the only English language Masters program in film in continental Europe

- The first year consists of courses in the key disciplines of filmmaking as well as hands-on film exercises and shorts.
- In the second year, the emphasis is on student's final project film in the area of their option – directing, production, cinematograhy, screenwriting or editing. Students have additional required courses in their option as well as workshops, and one-to-one tutoring.



SUMMER WORKSHOPS

MAKING A SHORT:

The intensive three week filmmaking workshop is designed to give students a thorough introduction to the craft of filmmaking through hands-on experience.

WRITING A SHORT:

The two week workshop consists of introducing students to the craft of professional screenwriting through a combination of instruction, dynamic pitch sessions and professional feedback.
