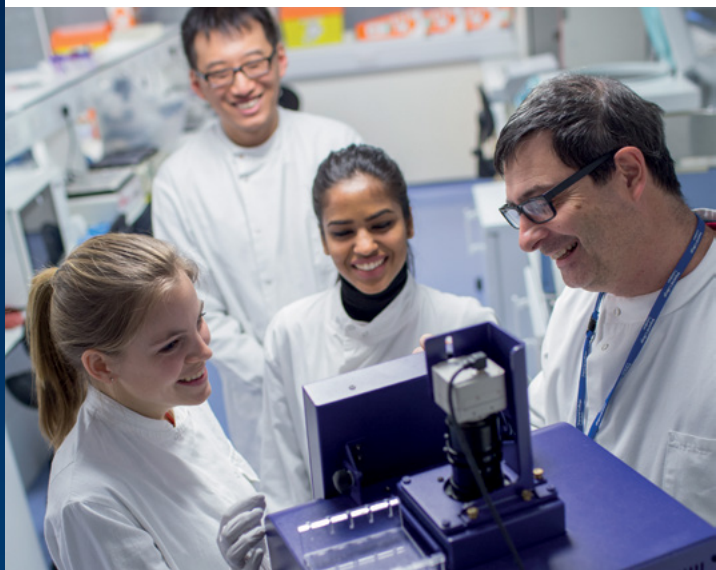


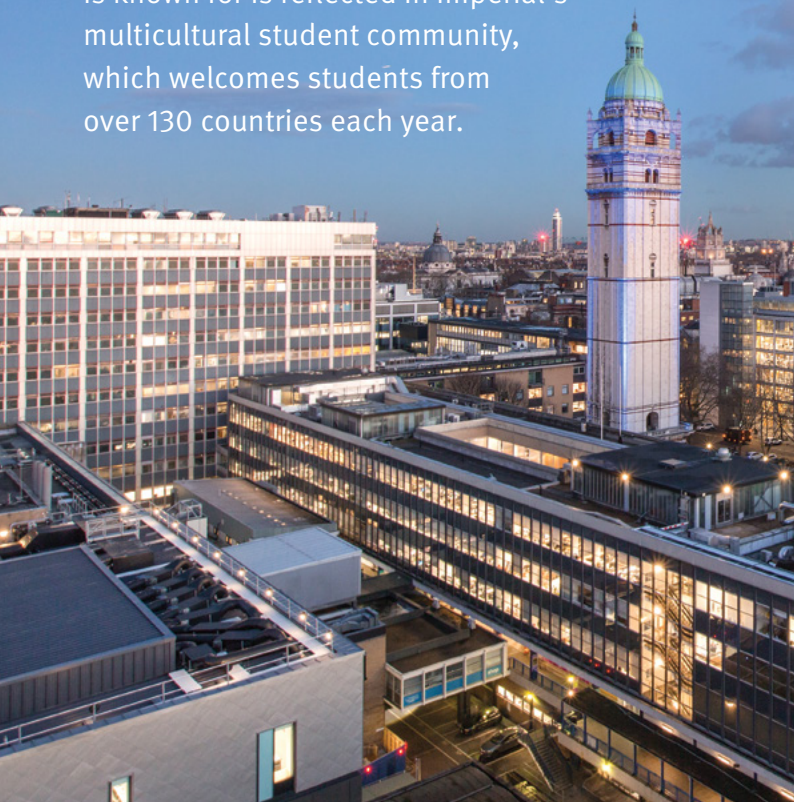

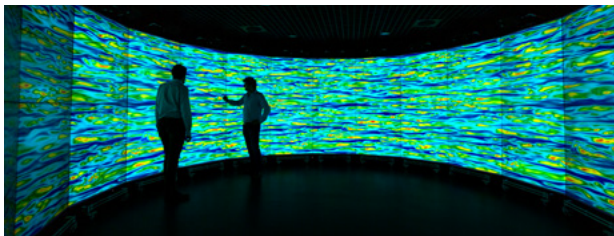

## SCHOLARSHIPS

Examples of current scholarships for South East Asian students include:

AWARD	COVERS
<b>World Scientific Scholarships (undergraduate)</b> Citizens of Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam	£5,000 for each year of undergraduate study for a maximum of four years
<b>Commonwealth Scholarships</b> Academically excellent citizens of developing Commonwealth countries, applying for Master's or PhD study	Tuition fees, maintenance grant, return economy airfare, some additional expenses
<b>President's PhD Scholarships</b> High-performing undergraduate or Master's students progressing to a PhD	Tuition fees, £21,600 stipend per annum, consumables fund and a bespoke development training programme
