New Students

Orientation Week

The first week of term is designed to help you settle in to campus life. There are a wide range of activities from student society fairs, sports fair, social events, introduction to facilities such as the library and IT systems, and your course induction programme. We offer pre-departure events every July.

Accommodation

Apply by 31 July each year for guaranteed University accommodation. Fees for undergraduate accommodation start from £89 per week (£3,680 for 42 weeks) with an average of around £159 per week (£6,617 for 42 weeks).

Tuition & Accommodation Fees

We offer flexible payment plans in 1 instalment, termly or monthly payments.

Founded in 1900, University of Birmingham is a large public university located on a 276 acre campus site in Birmingham, the second largest city in the UK. The University also has a campus in Dubai. Birmingham is consistently ranked amongst the top 20 in UK national league tables and amongst the top 100 universities globally. With over 34,000 students, including 9,000 international students from over 150 countries, our students are part of a truly vibrant and global community.

There are currently over 150 students from Indonesia studying on a wide range of programmes at the University. Admission Requirements

Academic requirements (Additional English language requirements may apply)

Foundation Year

Grades of 7.0/10 in the High School Certificate from year 12 (SMU3), to include 7.0 in Maths for our Engineering and Physical Sciences pathway.

The University will consider students who have taken GCE A Level examinations and the International Baccalaureate (IB) for entrance to undergraduate programmes.

Bachelors Degree

Holders of a Diploma (D2/D3) with good grades (GPA of 3.0 or higher), from a recognised Indonesian institution may be considered for entry to the first year (or possibly second year if it's a D3) year of an undergraduate degree programme

Masters Degree/ PhD

Holders of the 4 year Sarjana (S1) from a recognised Indonesian institution will be considered for postgraduate study at Birmingham. Entry requirements will vary and range from a GPA of 2.8 upwards, depending on course requirements and the institution at which you have studied. Holders of the Magister (S2) from a recognised Indonesian institution will be considered for postgraduate study at Birmingham. Holders of a Diploma (D4), with good grades (GPA of 3.0 or higher), from a recognised Indonesian institution may be considered for postgraduate study at Birmingham
