## Undergraduate

Typical offers for students taking A levels range from BBB to AAA. International Baccalaureate offers typically range from 30 to 36.

Students who have successfully completed one year of university in Indonesia can also be considered for direct entry.

Students with high school qualifications must take a foundation course to qualify for our courses.

## Masters

Masters applicants should hold a good bachelors degree from a recognised institution. Typical minimum entry requirements from Indonesian universities are a GPA of 3.0-3.25 out of 4.0.

## PhD research

PhD applicants must hold a masters degree of a good standard from a recognised institution and provide a research proposal when applying.

## English language

We accept a variety of academic English tests and qualifications, including IELTS, TOEFL iBT, Pearson PTE, GCSE, IB and O level English.

As a guide, fees for international students in 2020/21 include:

- Arts and social sciences courses from £18,420
- Engineering and science courses from £23,760
- MSc business courses from £24,975
- MSc finance and banking courses £29,970
- MBA courses £24,975
- Medicine years one and two £24,990 (years three–five charged at a clinical rate – £43,500 in 2020/21 and higher in 2022/23)

## Accommodation

We guarantee accommodation for all new students, subject to terms and conditions. Fees typically range from £110–250 per week, depending on the site, room type and contract length.
