APPLICATION PROCEDURE

STEP 1

Apply on Studielink.nl, the central online application tool for higher education in the Netherlands.

STEP 2

Send the necessary documents. A few days after applying on Studielink, HAN Admissions Office emails you about which documents to send.

STEP 3

You're invited for a Skype interview. This is to check whether the program is a good match for you.

STEP 4

Find out whether you've been accepted. HAN Admissions Office emails you the outcome of your application.

STEP 5

Received the acceptance letter? Paid the tuition fees? Then you're officially a HAN student.

APPLICATION DEADLINES NON-EU/EEA

Starting in September 2020? Apply before 1 June 2020.

Starting in February 2021?
Apply before 1 November 2020. *

* February start is only open for Communication and International Business

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

TUITION FEES NON-EU/EEA STUDENTS

The tuition fees for the 2019-2020 academic year are:

• Communication & International Business: € 7,290

Automotive Engineering, Chemistry,
 Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Life Sciences &
 Mechanical Engineering: € 8,540

Tuition fees are recalculated each year and may differ from the previous academic year. To check the tuition fees for 2020-2021 academic year, visit han.nl/tuitionfees.

VISA

To study in the Netherlands, you need the right visas and permits. Are you from a country outside the EU/EEA? Then you need a residence permit. You might also need an entry visa.

HAN arranges the residence permit and entry visa on your behalf. So you don't need to contact the IND (Immigration and Naturalisation Service) yourself. You do need to fill in some forms and provide the right documents.

Financial guarantee

To start the visa procedure, HAN needs to receive a financial guarantee from you. This includes:

- → payment of tuition fees for the 1st year of studies
- → proof of sufficient financial means of at least € 11,919

ORIENTATION YEAR

The Dutch government wants to offer all Dutch higher education graduates the opportunity to search for a job in the Netherlands. Non-EU/EEA graduates can apply for the 'orientation year highly educated persons' residence permit within 3 years of graduation. During this orientation year you are allowed to work in the Netherlands without restrictions.

COST OF LIVING

Most students spend between € 800 and € 1,100 a month. See below for an indication of your main costs per month:

- Renting a furnished room + utensils: € 380 € 450
- Food from the grocery store: € 200
- Insurance costs: € 100
- Books and study materials: € 50
- Public transport: € 50 100
- Telephone costs: € 30

SCHOLARSHIPS

HAN offers financial aid to talented bachelor students, in collaboration with the Dutch Ministry of Education and Science. Are you an outstanding achiever from outside the EU/EEA? Perhaps you're eligible for one of these HAN scholarships:

- → Orange Tulip
- 1st year of study: € 5,000
- 2nd, 3rd and 4th year of study: € 2,500
- → HAN Holland
- 1st year of study: € 5,000
- 2nd, 3rd and 4th year of study: € 2,500

You need to earn the necessary credits in your 1^{st} year in order to maintain the scholarship in your 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} and 4^{th} year.

Requirements:

- You are from a country outside the EU/EEA
- You have not been previously enrolled in a degree at a university or a university of applied sciences in the Netherlands
- You have been accepted into a full-time English-taught bachelor program
- You have an IELTS score of at least 6.5 or equivalent

How to apply?

Make sure your enrolment is complete before:

- → 1 April (September start)
- → 1 October (February start)

Do you meet the minimum requirements? Then you'll be selected to apply for a scholarship. You will receive an email with further information.

HOUSING


It's important to have a suitable place to live during your studies. A place within easy distance of the campus and where you can feel at home. The HAN Housing Office helps international students like yourself find a room.

HAN Housing Office makes it easy for students from outside the EU/EEA. Have you paid your financial guarantee? Then you get a guaranteed room. You can even choose and book the room yourself. Once your financial guarantee is processed, HAN Housing Office sends you an email with a voucher code. You use this code to book your room in the online booking system.

Rental prices are between €380 to €450 per month. Prices depend on the location, room size and service charges.

Starting in September? Your room is arranged for the 1st year of study. Starting in February? Your room is arranged for the 1st semester. After that you need to arrange the rental yourself.
