# THE DUEF, BRIDGE PROGRAM TO UNIVERSITY STUDIES

The **University Diploma of French Studies** (DUEF) of Université de Caen Normandie is a **217-hour semester-long intensive program** based on French language trainings covering the first 5 levels of the European framework for languages (CECRL).

Open to any candidate who can justify a title or diploma equivalent to the

French Baccalaureat, it serves sevelral objectives such as **discovering French language and culture** but also, for the intermediate to advanced levels, **preparing for French university studies in France** by combining practice of the language with progressive academic immersion (French for university purposes' track).

As a **degree program**, the DUEF is offered to students registered through one of our numerous exchange agreements with foreign institutions and transferring credits into their home diploma.

## SCHEDULE

• Semester 1: September 1<sup>st</sup> - December 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Registration deadline: July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021

• Semester 2:

January 12<sup>th</sup> - May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Registration deadline: December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021

Upon registration, candidates must provide the title or diploma recognized as equivalent to the French Baccalaureat and justify their language proficiency by taking an online placement test provided by *Carré international*.

Depending on their country of origin, candidates may be required to officially certified their language proficiency to complete their visa request (DELF/ DALF, TCF, TEF).

Beware: the DUEF training period exceeds 3 months and therefore requires applying for a **long-term student visa**.

### CERTIFICATIONS

• University Diploma of French studies (30 ECTS possible per semester)

 Possibility to register to one of the fee-paying exam sessions of DELF and DALF (A1 to C2) organized by Carré international at the end of each semester. €80 to €140\* depending of the exam.

## HOUSING / DINING

Option 1: **Campus housing** 100-sqft single room in one of the University residences managed by CROUS Caen

Normandie. All the residences and campuses are

served by public transportation (tramway or bus). Co-ed buildings with internet access.



Starting **€255\***/month, fully due per semester and/or academic year depending on program.

#### Option 2: Host family

Single room in Caen and suburbs, including daily breakfast and Internet access. Starting €420\*/ month.

For both options, an additional  ${\it \in 30}$  non-refundable booking fee will be charged for each academic year.

Lunches and diners can be taken in the numerous university restaurants and cafeterias.

Basic meal: **€3,30\*** 



Throughout the semester, cultural and recreational activities complete the language training program: excursions and visits, thematic evenings, creative workshops, etc.

DUEF students also have to opportunity to learn or improve, at a preferred rate, one of the 15 foreign languages offered each semester in night courses by *Carré international*:
