This version of the University Diploma of French Studies (DUEF) combines an on-line preparatory track and a semester in-person at University of Caen Normandy.

Part 1: **French-e - Language & integration on-line program**

54-hour preparatory course specifically developed by our French faculty and available on eCampus, UNICAEN distance-learning platform. Available to prepare DUEF A2, B1/ B1+ & B2, the course includes video presentations, digital resources, one-on-one video and chat sessions and 2 hours of individual follow-up.

Academic content: Oral and Written Communication, Grammar, Phonetics, Literature/ Culture and French Civilization.

- Part 2: **DUEF in-person in Caen**

Participants attend our regular intensive French language and culture DUEF program at the level assessed at the end of the on-line preparatory course.

REQUIREMENTS & CERTIFICATION

Students must assess **a minimum A1 proficiency** upon registration.

The on-line track cannot be offered as a stand-alone program; it is only available as a packaged offer with an on-person semester DUEF registration.

Providing that students successfully complete the program:

- **On-line program** > 6 ECTS equivalent
- **DUEF** > 30 ECTS + regular DUEF transcript
