Our bachelor's programs are all offered in German. Please inform yourself about the different study programs at the website. There you will find a detailed description of the contents and application deadlines. You can see the exact curriculum and the individual subjects in the module charts.

Please apply by our online applicant portal at www.tu-ilmenau.de/apply. The applications will be submitted online only. Please do not send any documents by post or e-mail.

The portal will guide you through the application process step by step. Please scan the following documents and upload them in the original and a German or English translation as a pdf-file into the portal:

- 1. (Higher) Secondary School Certificate (find information about the evaluation of your secondary school certificate at http://anabin.kmk.org)
- 2. Transcript of your university studies if you have done studies already
- 3. CV without blanks
- 4. Proof of sufficient German (minimal B1!)
- 5. Copy of a personal document showing the official spelling/transcription of your name and your birthday.

If your certificates allow it and if you have reached at least level B1 in German, you will receive conditional admission. You will then have to continue learning German up to level C1.

With the conditional admission, you can come directly to our German courses in the Academic Preparation Course (APC) at the university.

If your secondary school certificate does not correspond to the German Abitur, you will have to attend a preparatory college, e.g. the <u>Staatliches Studienkolleg Nordhausen</u>, and take an assessment test (Feststellungsprüfung) there.

You cannot apply directly to the Studienkolleg. You need to apply directly to the university for the desired course of study.

The application at the TU Ilmenau costs a fee of € 25,00.

The TU Ilmenau does not participate in the Uni-ASSIST application procedure.

A few days after you have submitted your application electronically, you will receive an email from us with the details for paying the fee. Please note that you may have to pay additional bank charges. Your application will be processed as soon as the fee has been received by the TU Ilmenau. The processing time for a Bachelor application takes about 4 to 6 weeks on average. It may take longer if there are a lot of applications.

An application for a bachelor's degree at the TU Ilmenau is open from January 16 to May 15 for the winter semester (semester starts on October 1).

However, we recommend that you apply as early as possible. This is the only way to ensure that you can complete your study application, visa application and travel preparations in time and be in Ilmenau in time for the start of your studies.

The TU Ilmenau does not award scholarships itself. On the website of the <u>DAAD</u> (German Academic Exchange Service), you find a database with information about possible scholarships.

The TU Ilmenau offers various master's programs. Please inform yourself about contents, language, admission requirements and application deadlines at the website. You can see the exact curriculum and the individual subjects in the module charts.

Please apply by our online applicant portal at www.tu-ilmenau.de/apply. The applications will be submitted online only. Please do not send any documents by post or e-mail. The portal will guide you through the application process step by step. Please scan the following documents and upload them in the original and a German or English translation as a pdf-file into the portal:

- 1. (Higher) Secondary School Certificate
- 2. Bachelor's Certificate and the corresponding transcript
- 3. Complete CV (without blanks)
- 4. Letter of motivation (mandatory for the Media and Communication Science program only).
- 5. Proof of your language skills in German or English (depending on the course language, minimum B2 level).
- 6. Copy of your passport, identity card or birth certificate (the official spelling or transcription of your name must be clearly legible).

For the master's programs, you will find a short description, the study regulations and the corresponding module descriptions as extra documents on the above mentioned website. There you also find detailed information about the exact contents of the course.

The conditions for admission to the respective master's program are described at the end of each study regulation.

Master Aptitude Test

The decision on admission to the master's courses is made by the examination board of the department responsible for the course. The decision is based on an evaluation of the documents you have submitted. The evaluation will check whether your previous study contents meet the subject related requirements of the master's program.

This evaluation is called Master Aptitude Test. Only in a few cases there will a personal interview be taken with you. Only your documents will be reviewed in standard cases.

The application period depends on the respective degree program. Generally applies:

Winter semester (semester start on 1 October): January 16 to May 15, Summer semester (semester start on 1 April): July 16 to November 15.

Please inform yourself at the website

if your course starts in summer and winter semester or in winter semester only. You cannot apply for winter semester programs in the application period for summer semester.

Please note that the application deadlines do not include any time to apply for a visa. The admission procedure for the master's programs takes eight up to 10 weeks on average. If you need a visa, you should apply two to three months before the application deadline. Otherwise, it might not be possible to arrive in time for the semester. Please enquire at the German Embassy in your home country how long the visa application process takes.

For admission, proof of your language skills in the course language is also required. The minimum level for an application (conditional admission) is language level B2.

For direct access to the German taught courses, TU Ilmenau requires the DSH-2 or the TestDaF 3x4+1x3, for the English taught courses IELTS 6.5 or an equivalent test is required. A former study program completed in English does not replace the required language certificate.

TU Ilmenau offers <u>Academic Preparation Courses (APC)</u> for all applicants who have to fulfill language or subject related requirements before beginning their studies.

You can apply online directly at the university. The TU Ilmenau does not participate in the Uni-ASSIST procedure. For the evaluation of your application, we charge a fee of € 25. Please transfer this amount only after you have received payment information from us. You will receive this a few days after transmitting your application.

The TU Ilmenau does not award scholarships itself. On the website of the <u>DAAD</u> (German Academic Exchange Service) you find a database with information about possible scholarships.
