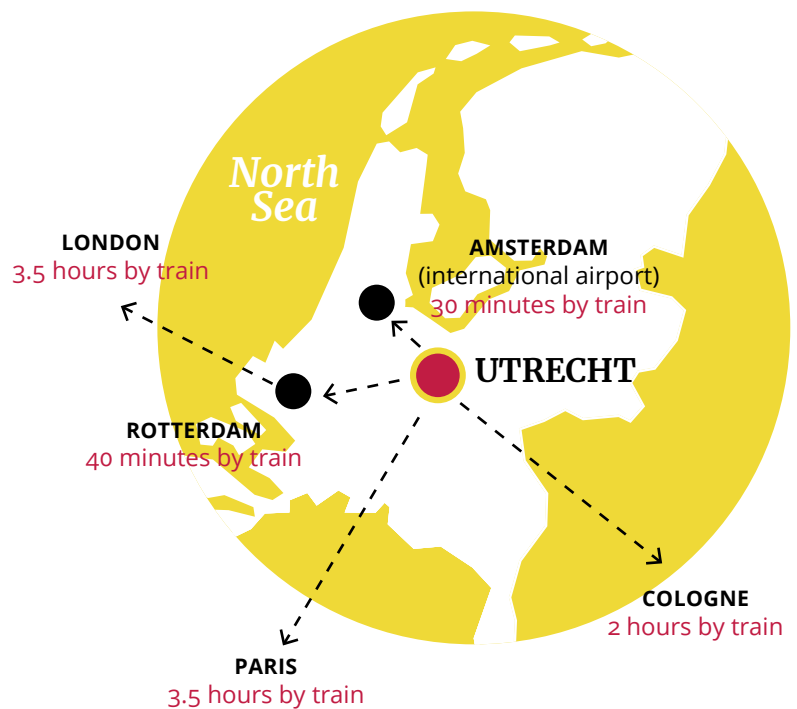
THE CITY OF UTRECHT

‘Gezellig’, a word deemed impossible to translate but at its most accurate, resembles “cosiness”, “a pleasant atmosphere”, or “general togetherness”. Utrecht is said to be an environment which embodies this word: a quintessential Dutch city which is both rich in history and embraces innovation/change at the same time. Home to one of the country’s largest university, Utrecht is the proud owner of a fresh and diverse student population which is not only reflected in the multitude of cultural events taking place at any given time, but also in the city’s focus on creating a hub of biodiversity.

UTRECHT HAS A SMALL-TOWN, “GEZELLIG” FEEL

The international nature of UU palpably extends to the spirit of the city, with around 60,000 students living in Utrecht. A young, international and creative vibe masks the city, making it home to a plethora of innovative technology and biodiversity start-ups/organisations, transforming the city into a playground for unique infrastructure and social initiatives. Despite these accolades, Utrecht has a small-town, “gezellig” feel. Paved with cobbled streets and scenic canals, there are activities on offer for all climates, such as grabbing a coffee before climbing the steps of the vast gothic Domtoren church or canoeing down the Oude Gracht (Old Canal) district and stopping for a drink along the many wharf cellar bars. Amongst other languages, English is widely spoken here, marking it as inclusive of its population. Utrecht provides a space for bright minds to flourish and achieve a better future.

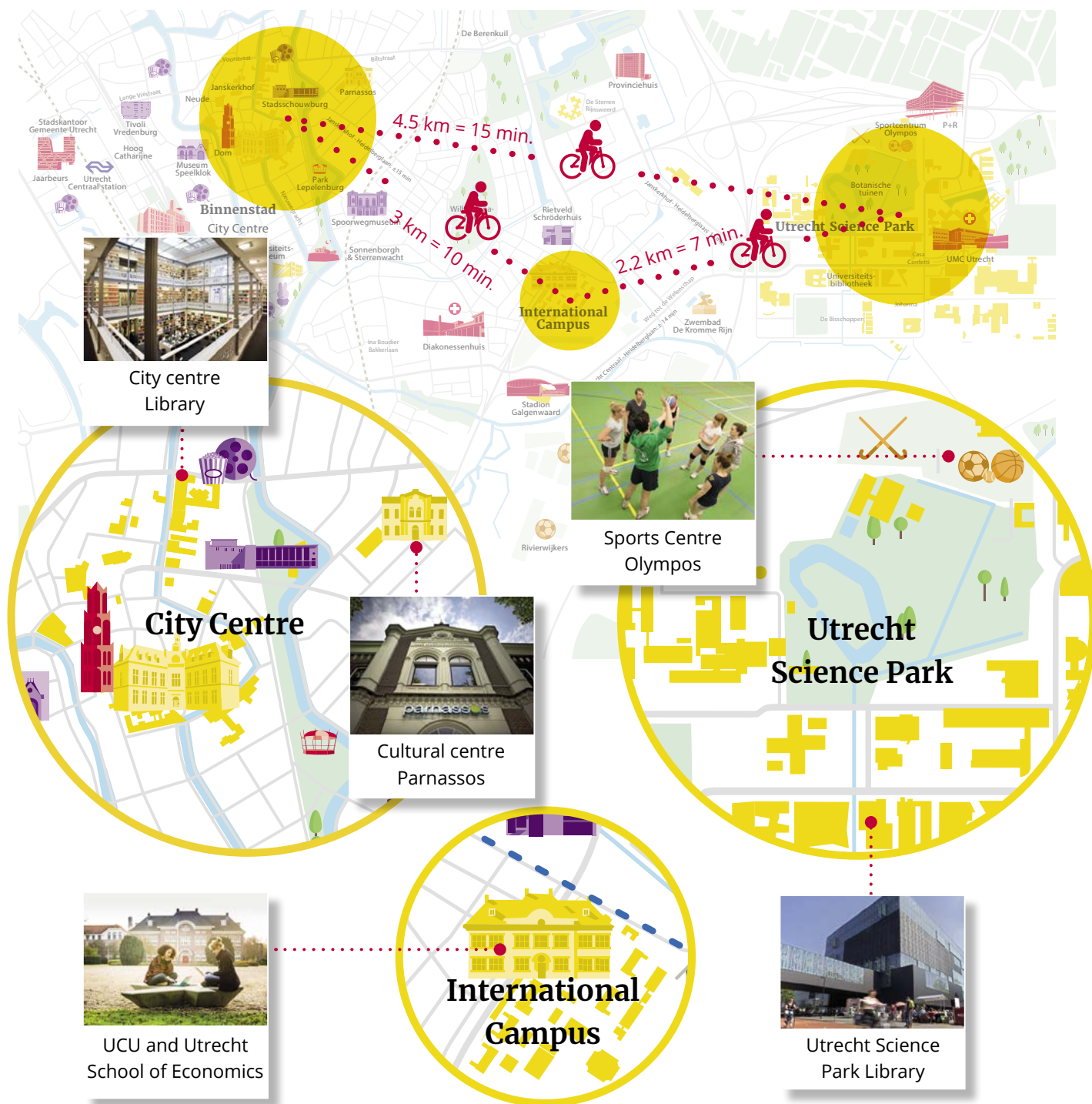
