Employability is at the heart of the MSc in Management – Grande Ecole Program. From the first year onwards, the program is constructed with a selection of courses that enable students to acquire essential management competencies and access a number of very valuable internships in highly sought-after sectors such as strategy consulting and finance.

A choice of courses to gradually build up a tailored specialization

At **emlyon** business school, students take the time to progress through their course and test different options before choosing a specialization. From the first year of studies, students have elective courses and core managerial skill courses that can be integrated with internships and academic exchanges. This gives students' career projects time to mature while they keep their options open and specialize one step at a time. Students can choose their own specialization by selecting disciplines in one or more fields, in addition to the option to completing an MSc course at emlyon or a double-degree course, in France or abroad.

DNA courses, the early makers signature teaching style

DNA courses enable our students to develop the vital skills and abilities they will need in a constantly changing world. Alongside the "Prototype" (digital toolkit) and "Disrupted Futures" courses, there are two flagship projects in the MSc in Management – Grande Ecole program. The first is the RECAPSS (Applied Research in Social Sciences) project. Right from students' arrival at the school, it brings them face-to-face

with the exciting world of knowledge and research in the Social Sciences. The second is the PCE (Business Start-up Project). From the initial idea through to examining business models and drawing up the business plan, the students conduct the entire business start-up process with guidance and support from the teaching team.

An international program

The international experience is an important part of the MSc in Management – Grande Ecole Program. You can choose to spend a semester studying at emlyon's international campuses (Mumbai, Bhubaneswar, Casablanca and Shanghai), or for an academic exchange at the site of one of our 190 academic partners around the world.

Several international double-degree programs are also available as part of the MSc in Management – Grande Ecole program. Student can follow a double-degree program with the University of Finance - Moscow (Russia), WHU Koblenz or EBS Business School (Germany), Aston Business School (UK), School of Economics and Management - Tongji University (China), HEC Montreal (Canada), etc.














Program structure





