Destination Jyväskylä The city of Jyväskylä, founded in 1837, is located in Central

Finland, some 270 kilometres (168 miles) north of the capital Helsinki. Jyväskylä is best reached by train, bus or plane. The connections are relatively frequent and the journey from Helsinki to Jyväskylä takes about 3.5 hours by train.

With the population of nearly 145.000, Jyväskylä is the seventh largest city in Finland. The city is a safe and pleasant place to live. Thanks to the short distances and lively urban centre, Jyväskylä is a "little big city", where all the services, shops, schools, and workplaces are close at hand.

The city that follows in the footsteps of the world-famous architect Alvar Aalto can offer visitors some amazing encounters with nature in the middle of the city as well as a variety of thought-provoking culture.
