

Tuition fee (non-EU/EEA)

12 000 €/academic year (1st August - 31st July)

Scholarships

Year 1: Early Bird 50 % of Year 1 fee (accept study place offer within 14 days)

Years 2-4: Academic Award 25-50% based on credits completed + Finnish language test

Master's degree

Notable!

Our mid-career Master's degrees require minimum 2 years (24 months) of documented relevant work experience after completing Bachelor's to be eligible to apply. Submitted document must be an identifiable work certificate given after employment, so contracts or appointment letters cannot be considered.

Master's degrees have a scope of **60 to 90 ECTS credits**, which gives a duration of **1 - 1.5 years**.

Tuition fee (non-EU/EEA)

12 000 €/academic year (1 August – 31 July)

Scholarships

Year 1: Early Bird 20 % discounted Year 1 fee (full payment by 31 May) **Final term:** Academic Award based on study credit accumulation

- 45 cr complete = 25% scholarship waiver for final term
- 60 cr complete = 50% scholarship waiver for final term

Living costs

- Minimum required for immigration 9 600 €/year (recommended 12 000 €)
- Work alongside studies max 30 h/week
