



New: Co-op in Third Year

Co-op (or work-study) programs offer many advantages. They introduce you to the world of work and enable you to apply your knowledge on the job. During a co-op year, your tuition is paid in full by your host company, and you receive a co-op salary (only for students who have completed the second year of the bachelor's program at EM Strasbourg).

EM Strasbourg has developed a triple degree program with HEC Liège in Belgium and the University of Hohenheim in Germany, as well as dual degrees with HEC Liège and the Hochschule Furtwangen, enabling students to acquire academic experience in various countries and an open mindset and thereby boosting their employability.



Study Tracks









Entrance Exam

Students of foreign or French nationality can take our international entrance exam (conditions apply to French applicants).

To enter first year:

- Application
- Interview
- Progressive English study track: B2 level in French required (DELF, DALF)
- Full English study track: B2 level in English required (TOEIC, TOEFL, IELTS, or in-house test)

To enter second year directly:

- Application
- Written English test (or IELTS, TOEIC, or TOEFL score)
- Interview
- Progressive English study track: B2 level in French (DELF, DALF) and English (TOEIC, TOEFL, IELTS, or inhouse test) required

To enter third year directly:

- Application
- Logical reasoning test in English (or GMAT / TAGE MAGE score)
- Written English test (or IELTS, TOEIC, or TOEFL score)
- Interview in English
- B2 level in English required (TOEIC, TOEFL, IELTS, or in-house test)
